













Mario and Luigi Box Builder

Print out the sheets, then follow the steps below. Kids, ask a grown-up for help!

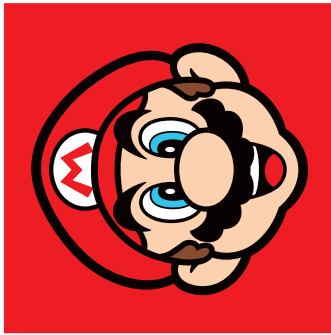
<p>1</p>  <p>Cut the pieces of paper along the dotted lines to make 6 squares.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Fold each of the 6 squares in half, then unfold them.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Fold the sides along the bold line to the middle.</p>	<p>4</p>  <p>Turn the piece lengthwise and fold the sides to the middle.</p>
<p>5</p>  <p>Open flaps at right angles.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Repeat steps 3-5 with the remaining sheets of paper.</p>	<p>7</p>  <p>Lay a piece on a flat surface, then stand a piece on top of it.</p>	<p>8</p>  <p>Slide in another piece, making sure the flaps go inside.</p>
<p>9</p>  <p>Repeat step 8 on the opposite side of the box.</p>	<p>10</p>  <p>Repeat step 7 on the opposite side of the box.</p>	<p>11</p>  <p>Slide the final piece into place, making sure no flaps are on the outside.</p>	<p>12</p>  <p>Your origami Mario is complete!</p>

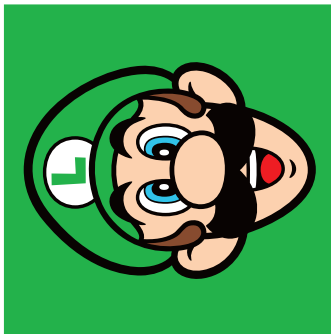
